LIBRARIANS' REPORTS

In addition to the librarians' reports, Ms. Olawski reported the Vacaville libraries had 180 summer reading participants at Cultural Center and 122 participants at Town Square. The Town Square library served as a meal site for Lunch @ the Library, distributing 539 lunches and gave away about 1,000 books. Ms. Olawski reported September is library card sign up month; she will obtain how many signups so far and report back to the Commission. Mr. McCallum reported KUIC is running a commercial for Solano County Library Card Sign Up month. He played the recording for the Commission. Ms. Valdez inquired about the Student Access Card program. Ms. Olawski stated the program at Vacaville Unified School District is active and it is expected that the new integrated library system (ILS) will create reports for each participating school district instead of an aggregate report.

a. FY 2022-2023 budget update - The Commission will hear a budget update and may take action.

Ms. Rollins moved to approve the revised FY 2022-2023 budget as presented: Mr. McCallum seconded. Motion carried. So ordered 3-0 vote.

Librarian's Report to the Vacaville Library Commission Vacaville Public Library-Cultural Center November 2022

Greetings, Commissioners:

Since the last Commission meeting, visitors to the Cultural Center Library borrowed 38,902 items over September and October. Our collection has also expanded to include musical instruments! This collection began at the Cordelia Library but has slowly been incorporated into other branches. We have the standard instruments of ukulele, classical guitar, and electric guitar—but we also have the unique experience of a collection that includes an accordion and a theremin! A mother told us her son has always wanted to learn to play an accordion. She was excited to tell us that her house sounded like a French bistro all weekend!

David, our teen services Library Associate, is starting a Teen Advisory Board. He's made a strong connection with a large group of teens (about 25 of them) from a homeschool group that is very excited to volunteer and help plan teen events. A couple of them have already signed up to be library volunteers and are already helping our children's staff prepare crafts for Storytimes. We are ecstatic to have a TAB again. It's been over three years since this library had one.

Nancy Redfield returned to Vacaville this month as our new Branch Manager. The position has been vacant for a few months. Longtime Commission members may recall that Nancy was the Supervising Librarian for the Cultural Center Library until the end of 2019. Nancy had been the Branch Manager overseeing Fairfield and Vallejo from 2020 until now. We're happy to have her back!

Events to Highlight:

After Hours Nintendo Night for Teens continues to be the last Friday of each month, from 5:30 to 7:30.

Afternoon Adventures in November are Tuesdays at 3:30 and include Video Games (11/8), Dinosaur Terrariums (11/15), and Votive Candle decorating (11/29).

Master Gardeners visit us Thursday, November 17 at 6 pm. This month, they will be discussing Fall cleanup and how to prepare for spring 2023.

We take a break from programming during the Thanksgiving week, so we will have no activities going on November 20-26.

Librarian's Report to the Vacaville Library Commission Vacaville Town Square Library (VTS) November 14, 2022

Greetings, Commissioners:

From September to October, VTS welcomed 15,681 visitors and circulated 16,806 items.

During the reporting period, staff presented 56 storytimes with 1,481 in attendance. 2,536 children and teens participated in library programs including Storytimes (Baby, Toddler, Outdoor, and Preschool), Afternoon Adventures, Graphic Novel Book Club, Teen Book Club, NorCal Bats, Spooky Stories & Crafts, PAWS, and Howl-O-Ween. We delivered a total of 240 books for the Reading at the Barbershop program!

Total attendance for outreach programs was 665. These included the Mobile Library school visits, Reading at the Barbershop, Markham Fall Fest, Farmers' Market Storytime, City of Vacaville Howl-O-Ween, and the Youth Roundtable. Upcoming events highlights include:

- Read to a Dog @ VTS: Thursday, November 17th, 4:00 5:00 PM. Our Read to a
 Dog program returns to the Town Square Library! Practice your reading with Graycee
 Mae the French Bulldog! Reading aloud helps children increase their vocabulary and
 comprehension. Children can build confidence reading with a PAWS for Healing
 volunteer and their dog.
- Pajama Storytime @VTS: Tuesday, December 13^{th} , 6:30-7:00 PM. Come dressed in your PJs and bring your favorite stuffy to snuggle while we listen to bedtime stories and sing sleepy lullabies. Then head home for your own sleep routine. This is an all ages/family storytime.
- West Valley Chorus Christmas Concert: Thursday, December 15th, 6:30 7:30 PM. Enjoy holiday favorites old and new! Everyone is welcome to this special holiday concert!
